Compass Card Brighton & Hove

Using this guide

This guide provides a snapshot of Compass Card Brighton and Hove offers and should be used as a quick reference only. Some of the offers are straight forward, but others are more complex and you will need more information. For full details and information about accessibility, download the free Compass Card app (search 'compass card' in the App Store for iPhones or Google Play for Android smart phones and download the Brighton and Hove version) or visit our Compass Card offers page at www.amazebrighton.org.uk You're usually expected to show or mention the Compass Card when you book, and to show it when you arrive to validate the Compass Card discount or special offer.

On pages 12 to 13, we've also listed Compass Card offers in West Sussex and beyond. You can access these by showing Compass Card Brighton and Hove.

Terms and conditions

1. Compass Card Brighton and Hove is valid for two years, or up until the child or young person's 25th birthday if that is less than two years from the card issue date. Amaze, the charity that manages the scheme, will remind you to renew the card the month before it expires and ask you to update the information we hold on the 'disability register' for Brighton and Hove (also known as 'The Compass'). Once that's done, we'll issue you with a new card.

2. The Compass Card Brighton and Hove 'card holder' referred to in this booklet is the child or young person with special educational needs or disabilities. The card can't be used by parent carers unless the Compass Card holder is present.

3. If Compass Card Brighton and Hove is lost or stolen, we can cancel the original card and

issue a replacement. Amaze reserves the right to charge £5 for the replacement. Contact the Compass Team at Amaze for more info (see contact details below).

4. Compass Card offers are subject to change and this guide doesn't include last-minute, ad hoc and free offers for Compass Card holders. Our regular e-bulletin, Compass News B&H, is a great way to keep up to date with all the latest offers, plus news and information about the things that matter to you - so make sure we have a current email address for you. You can also keep up to date with the Compass Card app – see above for more info. Remember to let Amaze know if you change your postal address, email address or 'phone number.

5. Card holders need to follow the rules at Compass Card venues and stick to the terms and conditions of the card. Although this happens rarely, Amaze reserves the right to withdraw the Compass Card if necessary.

Please note: Amaze wants to offer as many benefits to Compass Card holders as possible, but this doesn't mean we're giving our recommendation. We assume you will make your own decisions about whether Compass Card offers are appropriate for your child and whether leisure providers have suitable health and safety and child protection measures in place. However, we do want to know if you experience any problems with a particular venue or Compass Card Brighton and Hove offer. Please do contact us if this is the case.

• Make sure you have all the information you need about Compass Card offers by downloading our free Compass Card Brighton and Hove app. It provides you with an up-to-date, searchable list of Compass Card offers while you are on the move and its news function also keeps you up to date with the latest Compass Card and local leisure news. Search for 'compass card' in Google Play or in the Apple App Store and download the Brighton and Hove version. A lot of the information that appears on the app also appears on the Compass Card offers page on the Amaze website. • If you have an email address, sign up for our Compass e-bulletin, Compass News B&H. Sent to around 1500 Compass Card families most weeks (usually Thursday afternoon/evening), it's jam-packed with special offers, freebies, information on local services and events and much, much more. If you've provided Amaze with an up-to-date email address and you're still not receiving it, do check your junk mail folder. If you're still having problems, call the Amaze helpline on **01273 772289**.

• We've known families use the Compass Card Brighton and Hove as far afield as Florida and Rome, so it's worth showing it to all leisure providers, whether they have a Compass Card offer or not, to see if you can get a discount. If you get a deal somewhere unexpected, be sure to tell us so we can let other people know (or we may be able to organise an official Compass Card deal). Amaze

Amaze is a Brighton-based charity that works with parents of children and young people with disabilities and special educational needs and provides some services to young people themselves. Our services include: a helpline (call **01273 772289**); one to one support with education issues and Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence (PIP) applications; help with preparing for adulthood; a range of specialist publications and an informative web site (**www.amazebrighton.org.uk**); and training and workshops for parents.

The Carers' Card

Carers need looking after too and Brighton & Hove City Council's Carers' Card provides around 60 local offers and regular workshops and events to help carers take care of their own health and wellbeing.

Parent carers who look after a Compass Card holder automatically qualify for the free Carers' Card. Call the Integrated Child Development & Disability Team on **01273 295153** or email **carerscard@brightonhove.gov.uk** to apply – you'll need to provide the name, address, date of birth, email address and mobile phone number of all family members who are regular carers and who want to apply for a Carers' Card. This could include siblings who have a caring role and who are aged 8 to 25 years old (they'd be issued with the 'Young Carers' version of the Carers' Card). You'll also need to provide the name and date of birth of the Compass Card holder, the number on the back of the Compass Card and the expiry date on the back of the card. The Carers' Card is issued for two years.

Gully's Days Out

Established by Albion in the Community in partnership with American Express[®], Gully's Days Out provides young people and adults with additional needs with opportunities to experience many of Sussex's greatest attractions including Sea Life Brighton, Butlin's, Cineworld, Frankie & Benny's, Brighton Pier, Inspire Leisure and many more. Gully's Days Out membership is available to both individuals and organisations (Day Centres and SEND Schools) and members can request up to five tickets to attractions and enjoy a day out with friends and family. The scheme also provides supported days out, which are attended by trained AITC staff and volunteers from American Express[®], all of whom have received disability awareness training. They're on hand to provide respite for parents and carers and make sure everyone has a great day out.

Compass Card holders are automatically eligible for Gully's Days Out and will receive their own unique membership number. Just send in a completed application form with a copy of the Compass Card (front and reverse). Membership is £10 a year for individuals and £40 a year for organisations.

City Leisure Card

Brighton & Hove City Council has a Leisure Card for students who have an NUS Extra Card and for residents who receive Job Seekers Allowance; Employment and Support Allowance: Pension Credit; Income Support; Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payment (PIP); Attendance Allowance; Employment & Support Allowance/Incapacity Allowance; Universal Credit; or Child Tax Credit (up to First Threshold limit only). The card gives a 40% discount on swimming, fitness suite, fitness membership, squash, badminton and table tennis in Freedom Leisure centres in the city (King Alfred, Moulsecoomb Community Leisure Centre, Portslade Sports Centre, Prince Regent, Stanley Deason, St. Luke's Swimming Pool and Withdean Sports Complex) - and if you're eligible for the card, any children up to the age of 16 you have also benefit. Ask at your local leisure centre for details. To apply for a card, you'll need to show evidence of your identity and proof you're receiving one of the appropriate benefits.
